WHAT WE WILL DO: PRACTICAL ACTIVITIES

- Dissemination with students: laboratory teaching methodology
 - Carrying out cooperative learning activities (i.e. flipped classroom activities) among different classes
 - Create study and evaluation material together with the students
- Dissemination with colleagues and management: sharing new perspectives
 - A cooperative learning course for 20 teachers
 - A dissemination of KA1 Mobility through an event addressed to the school community and the territory
 - Implement the importance of offering several and different courses in order to get students motivated
 - Pay more attention to environmental sustainability and learning environments: install water dispensers in school, take care of the courtyard area, improve recycling in classrooms
